



Vaccine Schedule (based on AAP and CDC recommendations as of April 30, 2025)

Birth to 1 month	Hepatitis B #1 *	1 injection
2 months	Pentacel (DTaP/IPV/Hib) #1 PCV #1 Hepatitis B #2 Rotavirus #1	3 injections, 1 oral
4 months	Pentacel (DTaP/IPV/Hib) #2 PCV #2 Rotavirus #2	2 injections, 1 oral
6 months	Pentacel (DTaP/IPV/Hib) #3 PCV #3 Rotavirus #3	2 injections, 1 oral
9 months	Hepatitis B #3	1 injection
12 months	Varicella #1 MMR #1 Hepatitis A #1	3 injections
15 months	Prevnar #4 HiB #4	2 injections
18 months	DTaP #4 Hepatitis A #2 (can be given at 2 years)	2 injections
4 years	Proquad (Varicella #2, MMR #2) Kinrix (DTaP #5, IPV #4)	2 injections
11 years	Tdap Meningococcal ACYW #1	2 injections
12-14 years	HPV #1 ** HPV #2 **	2 injections (at least 6 months apart)
16 years	Meningococcal ACYW #2	1 injection
16-18 years	Meningococcal B #1 Meningococcal B #2	2 injections (at least 6 months apart)

*Hepatitis B vaccine schedule shown is based on Mom testing negative for HepBsAg. Schedule may be different if Mom tests positive or if result is unknown (due to possible transmission risk to infant).

**Optional, but recommended

Pentacel (1 injection): DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), IPV (Polio), HiB (Haemophilus Influenza B)

Rotavirus: Oral vaccine

PCV: Pneumococcal

MMR (1 injection): Measles, Mumps, Rubella

Varicella: Chicken Pox

Tdap: Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis

HPV: Human Papillomavirus (Optional, but recommended)
